
## A Focus On Growth

Back in 2013, KIPP educated about 3,000 students across eight public charter schools in the San Francisco Bay Area. The goal, however, was to grow to 20 schools—a fact that quite frankly worried the accounting team.

At the time, the school's AP functions, corporate credit card program, vendor invoice management and expense reimbursement systems were entirely paper based. The accounting team manually logged virtually all non-personnel expenses. And the office was lined with rows of file cabinets equally crammed with paper invoices and expense reports.

Invoice processes were time intensive, error prone and void of transparency.

KIPP's manual process took man-hours away from more pressing matters, and it also meant mistakes. Take a look.



## **Best Practices Any Organization Could Learn From**

## Sometimes, spending more saves more.


For KIPP, the cost of SAP Concur is roughly the same as one accounting associate. But this could this could help them avoid hiring two FTEs in the future—and that's an ROI leadership looks for.

## Paperless processes drastically simplify the audit process.

Under the old system, the school kept on-site paper records for all its expense transactions. Auditors requested samples of records for review, and two teams spent two full days pulling and refiling records. By going paperless, KIPP no longer has to maintain paper records, and the audit team goes directly into Concur for samples of expense transactions.

## Train, train, train, and give people time to adjust.


Instead of seeking to train users individually, the accounting team provided school Operations Managers with videos and other materials to educate school staff on the new systems. The accounting team also communicated very clear deadlines, with long lead times, largely mitigating any organizational resistance.



### SIMPLIFYING REIMBURSEMENT:

- The Expenselt mobile app now allows staff members to take photos of receipts, which are automatically uploaded to Concur for coding
- Expense reports are created electronically and take much less time to complete
- All approvals are electronic and any problems are resolved electronically, not manually
- All reimbursements are done via ACH direct deposit, versus cutting manual checks

Reimbursement and corporate credit card processes were also positively impacted by the switch to Concur. Before, employees had to fill out a complex expense reimbursement report, then number, annotate and tape their receipts to the report. It was an onerous process for the employee, cumbersome for the accounting staff, and time consuming for both.
